Ask your child questions about the book to ensure they have understood what they have read. The **Monkey Reading Records** will be issued with the books. This is an invaluable communication tool between school and home and allows us to keep track of progress.

Curriculum: The included sheet gives details of what your child will be learning this term. The IPC units we will be covering are called 'The Senses'.

Homework: The children will receive homework every Friday, which will link to what they have been studying in class. Homework is due back the following Wednesday. Please encourage your child to complete this, and allow them to be as independent as possible.
