PLAYGROUND BAGEL PROJECT

You may be aware that Hammersmith and Fulham have promised a free breakfast to all the children in the Borough alongside the organisation Magic Breakfast https://www.magicbreakfast.com/. This is now being rolled out by some schools and we will trial the method of a playground bagel.
