SCHOOL UNIFORM

Please can we remember the **school uniform** requirements:

- Grey/black skirts or trousers
- plain grey tights or grey or white socks
- school polo or plain white polo top or white shirt
- school sweatshirt /cardigan/ fleece or plain dark blue jumper
- plain dark blue headscarf or hair bows
- Plain black school shoes, not trainers.
- for PE, children bring in blue shorts, white or blue T shirts and trainers.

It is the responsibility of parents and carers to provide the right uniform for the children. We do not feel comfortable to put too much pressure on the children who do not have the right uniform as they don't provide it. Most can be purchased at shops locally.

EVIDENCE LETTER REQUESTS

Any parents who require a letter from the school as evidence for the Home Office, or benefits etc. must give at least 7 days' notice for the letter to be completed for collection. This can be a time-consuming activity and involve quite a lot of work and research so we need time to complete this.

If sufficient notice is not given, we may not be in a position to provide the letter within the required timeframe. To avoid disappointment we strongly advise parents / carers to adhere to the notice period as stated above.

There is an £8.00 charge for this service.

REMINDER - OLD OAK IS A NUT FREE SCHOOL

Our "Nut-Free Policy" means that the following items should not be brought into school:

- Packs of nuts
- Sandwiches with Nutella or chocolate spread
- Peanut butter sandwiches
- Fruit and cereal bars that contain nuts
- Chocolate bars or sweets that contain nuts
- Sesame seed rolls (children allergic to nuts may also have a severe reaction to sesame)
- Cakes made with nuts
