

## **Week 10 IPC work**

### Cities and counties of the UK

This week you have 2 tasks to complete.

#### **Task 1**

Look at the **Map of Cities in the UK**. In the box at the bottom of the page there are a list of UK cities. Can you correctly identify where each city is in the UK. Write your answers in the boxes provided.

**Challenge.** Can you find out which are the most populated and least populated cities?

#### **Task 2**

On a blank map of the UK, can write down where you think each city in the **English Cities** list is located. You can use the colour map of English counties to help.

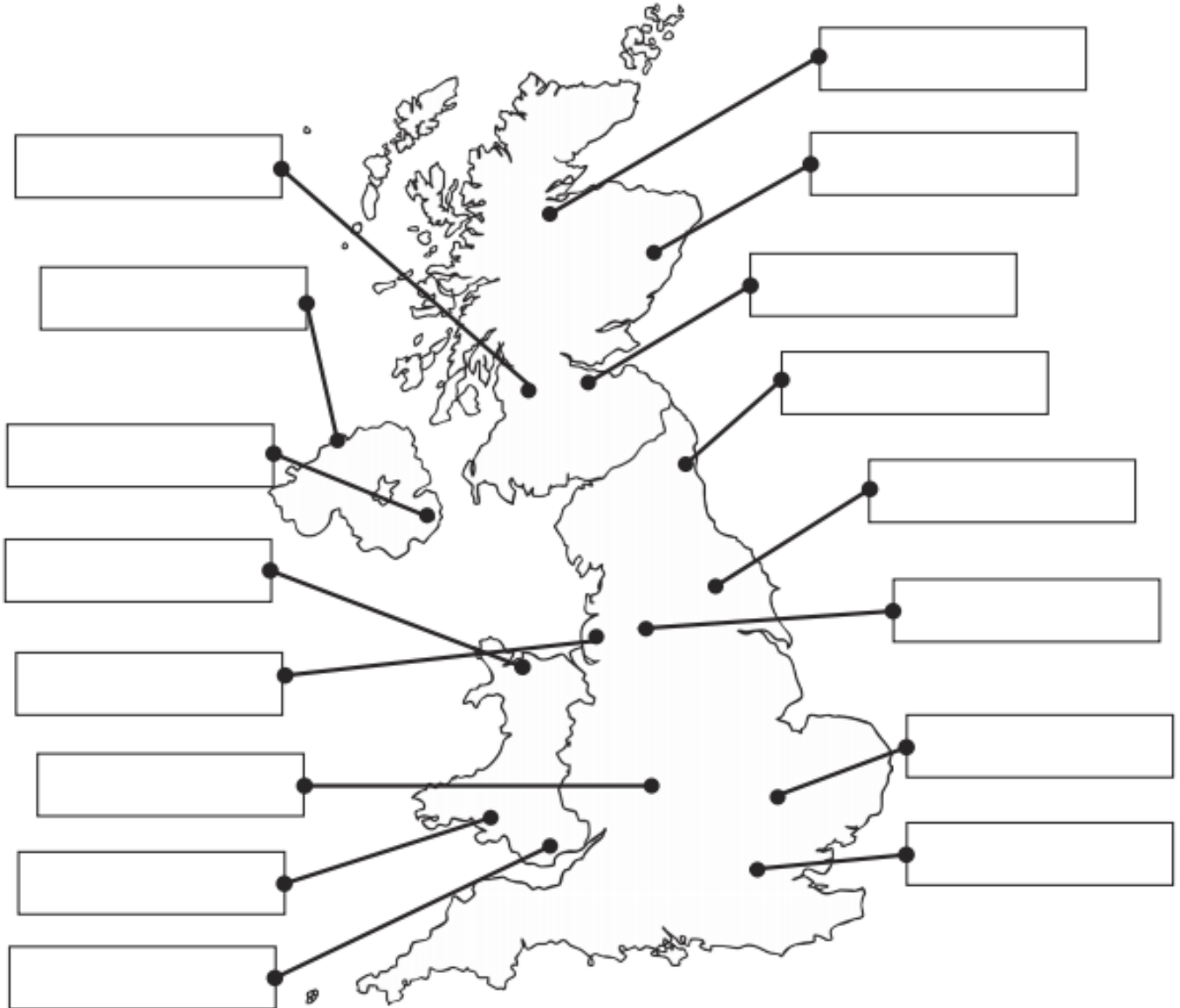
For example: Number 1 on the list is Liverpool, Merseyside. Liverpool is the city and Merseyside is the county. Merseyside is number 10 on the county list. I then look for number 10 on the colour map. I can then see that Merseyside is in the north west of England. Then on my blank map, I can write Liverpool where the number 10 (green colour) is located. Try and do the same for the rest of the cities on the list. The county colour map is there to help you! The extra list starts with Manchester.

**Challenge.** Can you also find where the extra list of cities are located? And can you find out what county they are in?

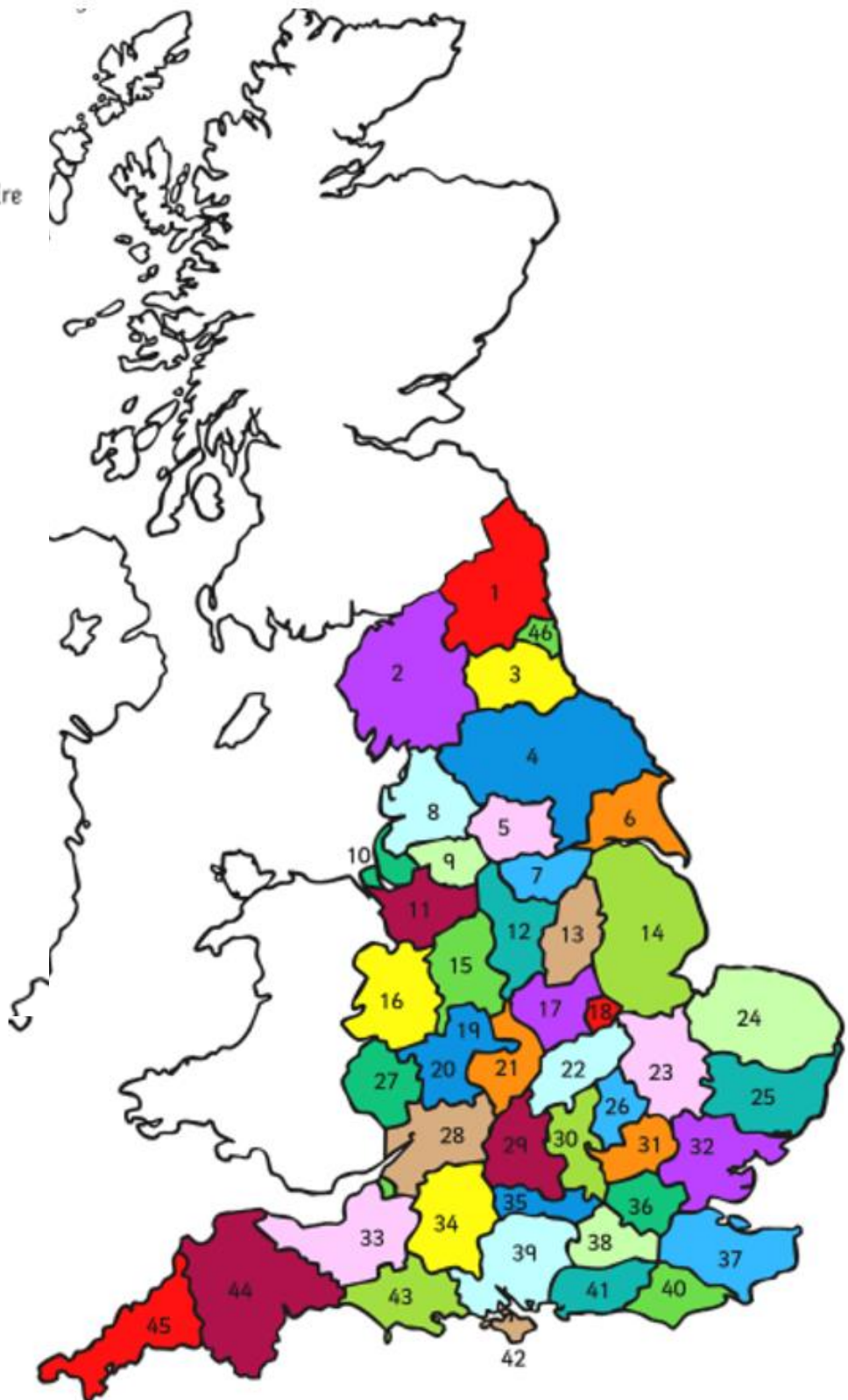
