In Charlie and the Chocolate Factory, Violet Beauregard chews gum which tastes like a three-course meal.

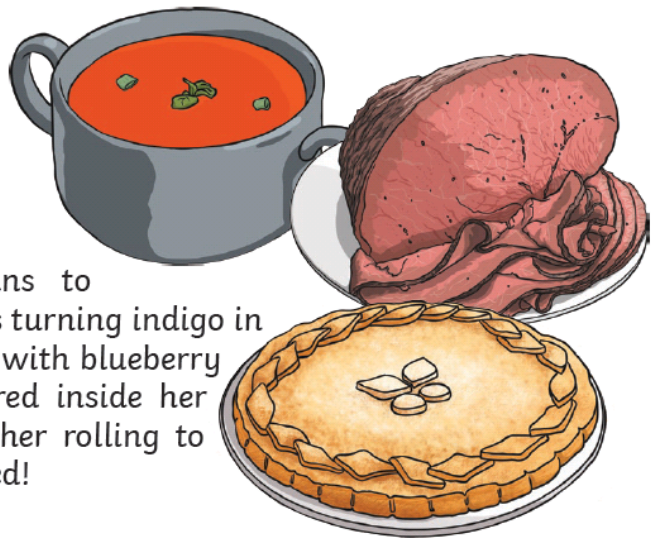
Willy Wonka's Gum Menu
