LO: I can design and make my own Marble Maze



Which materials do you have at home which can be used to make your maze?

Yr 5 & 6, check out these cool Marble Mazes which have been made using everyday materials. This week you are going to focus on design and design and make your own!



DESIGN YOUR MAZE ON PAPER FIRST. TRY AND MAKE IT QUITE DIFFICULT. YOU ARE GOING TO TEST IT OUT ON YOUR FAMILY MEMBERS!

A shoe box, paper plate or lego will all work well as your base.

1. Mark out and draw your maze map on your base. This is not necessary if you are using lego
2. Using straws, pieces of sponge, lolly pop sticks, card, lego or what ever you find at home cut and stick these on to your mapped out maze. Top Tip - Sellotape is better to use than glue. Write the word 'Start' in one corner of your maze and in the opposite corner the word 'End'
3. If you are using lego place the pieces down in the pattern you want to create for your maze

You will now need a marble

The aim is to challenge your family members to play your new game and try and get the marble from the start of the maze to the end of the maze in the quickest time!

Who do you think will be the best at your new game?

If you have time decorate the outside of your box or base!
