AFTER SCHOOL CLUBS

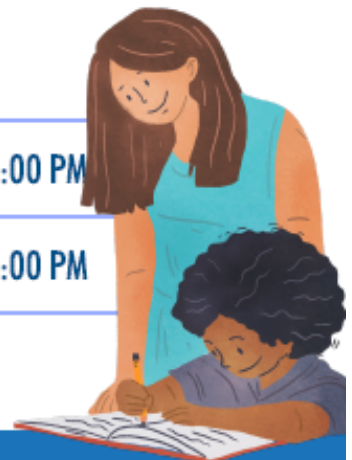
