We enjoyed an assembly today from Chloe from Beat the Street. Beat the Street is a free, fun initiative that will see Hammersmith & Fulham transformed into a giant game! Everyone in the Old Oak community is invited to play – pupils, teachers, parents, carers and even grandparents can get involved! Every child will have received a map and a pack of game cards today – one for them and one for a parent/carer. If you would like more game cards for additonal family members these can be picked up at different spots around the local area – please see the map. Play by earning points as you travel by finding Beat Boxes, which will be placed on lamp posts around the local area. Tap at least 2 Beat Boxes in one hour to start earning points – the more boxes you tap the more points earned so this a perfect chance to earn points when travelling to school, going to the parks and adventures on the weekend! 
