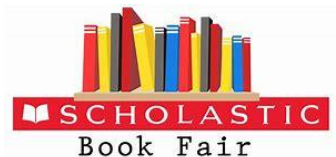
PARENT WORKSHOP: TUESDAY 28th NOVEMBER
