SPID THEATRE'S FAR FAR AWAY PROGRAMME: HOMECOMING April 16 - July 16 2024

Key Stage 2 have been lucky to work with SPID (Social, Progressive, Interconnected, Diverse) Theatre group this term, with each class taking part in an expressive arts workshop. SPID are offering a FREE programme, starting soon!

'Homecoming' is a free 12-week after-school program for 8-13 year olds. Using different art forms we will investigate together the meaning of "Third Place". 'Third Place' is a term coined by sociologist Ray Oldenburg in 1982 and refers to spaces where people spend time between the 'first place' of home and the 'second place' of work or school.

This upcoming block will have arts and crafts, movement and dance, devising and poetry, voted most popular by previous participants of the Far Away programme. The last session will be a 'Showing' day where we invite friends and family of the participants to come and witness what the children have been working on.
