Dear families,

The first week has brought a number of special moments. The highlight was the Sharing Assembly today, when our school nursery joined us to show their amazing train, built following the design of the new HS2 trains! This followed a visit to the site in May. It was the children's first sharing assembly and they sat so beautifully throughout.

The rest of sharing assembly celebrated mathematics in reception class, The Good Samaritan story in Year 1 as part of the topic Religious Stories. Year 2 shared their understanding of Hinduism, and Year 3 showed their art work based on the book in class 'Lob'. Year 4 celebrated the behaviour of children on their recent trip to the Kayaking Centre and their success in the Cricket tournament earlier this week. Year 5 retold the story of Macbeth, and Year 6 showed their models of the inside of the human body within the ribcage. The assembly was a celebration of the range of learning across the school, which runs alongside the core curriculum of maths and English.

Good luck to our Year 1 and Year 4 children who are sitting their phonics screening and the multiplication test next week. These are national benchmarks which every child across the country completes at this time.
