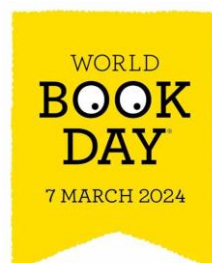
***MOTHER'S DAY BREAKFAST – WEDNESDAY 13th MARCH ***

YEAR 6 – JUNIOR CITIZENS

On Wednesday, Year 6 took part in a workshop with the Junior Citizens Trust at Craven Cottage Stadium. During their visit, the children experienced seven different safety scenarios, led by the Met Police, London NHS, London Fire Brigade, London Transport Police and Fulham FC. Each scenario was designed to be interactive, with the children taught a variety of life skills which focus upon how to keep themselves safe whilst potentially helping others who may be in difficulty or distress. The experience was invaluable and will prepare the children for the next stages in the life as they move to secondary school and beyond.



YEAR 5 – TRIP TO THE VICTORIA AND ALBERT MUSEUM

On Thursday, Year 5 went on an exciting maths themed trip to the V&A Museum, taking part in a workshop called “Pattern, Shape and Me”. 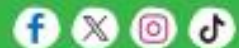

2 Add family members, and register a card to player profiles. Set up a team or join an existing one.



3 Start your journey. Find your nearest Beat Box using a paper or digital map and hover your card at the contactless Beat Box until it beeps and flashes. If playing with the app, tap the Beat Box icon on your phone and swipe to collect points.



4 Visit 2 Beat Boxes within an hour and collect 10 points for each Beat Box – this is 20 points for the journey.



5 Carry on your journey. Score 10 points for each extra Box you visit.

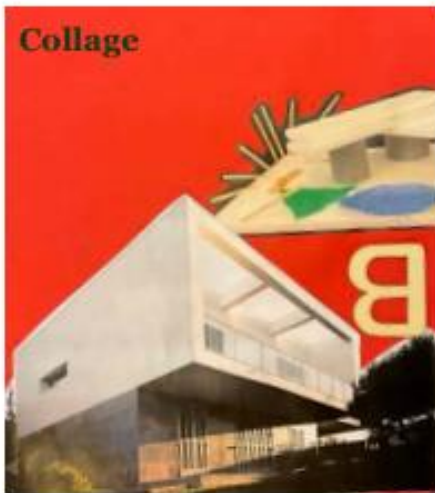

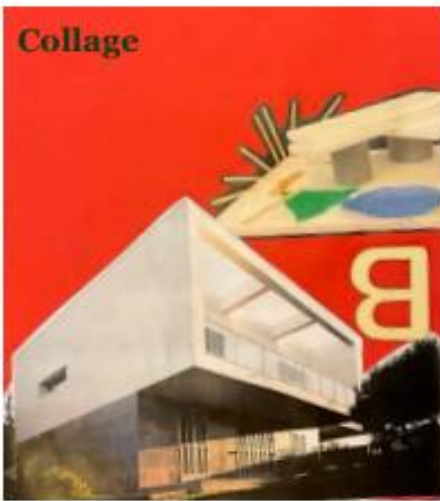
