We hope you are all well. The children have had a fantastic week and are very settled into their new classes. We know that sometimes you can ask, did you have a good day? And the response is very limited. Try using questions that are open such as, what was the most interesting thing you learnt today? What made you laugh or smile? Who did you eat with today and what did you talk about? What was the hardest thing you did today? We know you appreciate how important is to talk with our children and by asking a few questions the conversation should get started!

The Forest School Club for Early Years and Key Stage One has starting again- the children had a fantastic time exploring the outdoors. As we all know time spent in nature is always beneficial for us all.

Choir will be starting next Tuesday at lunchtime- one of my favourite parts if the week! We will be preparing for a Christmas festival with many other schools in the borough, this is always a fantastic event.

Children in years 3,4 and 5 met their new music teacher from the music hub on Tuesday- the sessions went really well. Children in Year 3 and 4 learn the recorder and Year 5 learn the Ukelele. Year 6 have drumming sessions on a Friday with Justin. The children also receive a weekly music and singing assembly where they learn about different genres of music, look at the history of music, listen to different artists and composers as well as singing themselves, its always fabulous to hear them!

Start of the day

Thank you to all our families who ensure their child is at the gate at 8:45am when it opens, or shortly after so they do not miss the bell at 8:50am. There are far too many families where children arrive around 9 am and after, if your child is 5 minutes late every day this means they miss 3 days of school across the academic year- add this to illness too they could be missing a lot of learning. 10 minutes late, which was 11 of our families this week, means their child/ren miss a whole week of learning. Tube strikes did not help this week and we understand that at times matters are out of your control. As a school we try and support and work with families so if there is anything we can do to help you get to school on time, please let us know.

Please remember that **school starts at 8;50am**, the key stage 1 and 2 gates open at 8:45am and you can drop your child to be looked after by staff. If you are later than 8:55am the gates will close and your child will be late on the register. Please work with us so children arrive on time, settle into class and start learning straight away.

Early years gate opens at 8:50am- if you are later than 9:05, your child will need to be taken to the front desk area and you will need to wait until they are collected at 9:30am. We do not have staff that can go to and from gates when they are settling children and starting the day.

<u>Breakfast Club</u>: if your child attends, please ensure they arrive before 8:15am, it starts at 8am. Any child that arrives after 8:15 will not be able to be permitted. This is for safety reasons as we are aware that some children are entering the building and not being registered as they go outside where the children go at 8:30 as part of the breakfast club offer.

<u>After School Club:</u> the children will go straight there after they are dismissed at the end of the day as usual. Please collect by 5:45pm.

Please see the letter about a new initiative taking place during the hours of after school club.

Arts and crafts, board games and multisports are on offer!

Each club works out at £4 a week, please see Joanne to secure your child a place.

Attendance and punctuality:

Attendance has been really positive this week, 93.4 % compared to 90% last week-. We have set ourselves an ambitious target of 94% attendance overall this year- we only achieved 89% 24/25.

Punctuality. I see many families come through the key stage one gate at 9 am and some as late as 9;10 every day. As is said before missing this much learning every day and the disturbance to their settling and transition is really detrimental to children, please work with us it is much appreciated and benefits your child/ren.

School lunches

The children are thoroughly enjoying the meals cooked by Fabiano, our new school cook. As you are aware we work with the company STIR. The number of children who are eating a school lunch has increased- please remember that in London EVERY child receives a free school lunch. There are many choices for the children to choose at lunch time so even if you think your child may not like what is on offer, they could try for a week and see! If you choose to give your child a packed lunch please ensure it is nutritious.

Vacancies:

We are recruiting for an **Early year's practitioner who has a level 3 in childcare** to work in the Imperial Nursery-this role is all year round with annual leave, NOT term time- 12:15pm-5;30pm every day. (25 hours) Please ask Joanne for an application form if you are interested.

We will be interviewing for our new site manager position the week beginning September 21st.

We are looking for someone who is interested in an **administrative apprenticeship** where you are placed in the school for approximately 20 hours a week and also receive training provided by an external team- for any more information or to register interest, please speak to Kelly Williams, our school business manager.

<u>Illness:</u> If your child is unwell, you MUST call the school office and speak to someone or leave a voice message. You can also email, <u>admin@oldoak.lbhf.sch.uk</u>. Please put child absence in the email heading. If you do not do this then it means we need to call you to ascertain why your child is unwell.
