Dear families,

A very Happy New Year to you all! We hope that 2026 is a wonderful year for you all.

We have had a fantastic first week back, the children have settled to routines and seem motivated to learn. We have spent time in classes and in assemblies considering new year resolutions/intentions and talked about a new year being seen as a fresh page, a new chapter and a way to move forward. It is so important for young people to always start every day as a new day- often if they have not had a positive day before knowing that tomorrow will be better is just what they need to recognise.

Staff have worked together on re-writing and updating our behaviour, wellbeing and pastoral policy which I will send to all families. We work with you in partnership and we all have a role to play in promoting and managing the positive behaviour management, wellbeing and pastoral care of our children.

Year 5 have started swimming sessions this week, this is a fantastic opportunity for our children and for some this will be the first time they have been swimming. Here at Old Oak, we pride ourselves on ensuring every child gets as many opportunities as they can whilst they are in our care.

There is a taster cheerleading session being planned so watch this space as your child may be interested in this, the scrubs forest club will re start with new children having this wonderful opportunity in key stage one and other clubs all start next week.
