Nursery Admissions

We are delighted to be holding our Nursery Open Afternoon on Monday 13th July from 3.30pm.

We currently have places available for 3 and 4-year-olds, and this is a wonderful opportunity for prospective families to visit our nursery, explore our learning environment, and discover the many exciting opportunities available at Old Oak. If you know of any families in the local area who are looking for a nursery place, we would be very grateful if you could help spread the word.

We welcome both 15-hour and 30-hour funded childcare codes. For families requiring additional sessions, these are available at a cost of £20 per morning or afternoon session.

Funding begins in the term following your child's third birthday. However, if you would like your child to start attending as soon as they turn three, paid sessions are available until funding commences.

Attendance and Punctuality

Thank you to all of the families who are on time and ensure their child/ren are in school on time. The classes enjoy the races and the rewards if their class wins.

Congratulation to this week's attendance winners Year 2 Chestnut with a fantastic 97% - you managed to knock Aspen off the top spot!

Well done to Year 5 Aspen who both only had 1 late this week.

If your child is really unwell, they need to stay at home but we need them in as much as possible. **If a child misses a day a fortnight, they miss 20 school days, that is one month of missed education over an academic year. If they miss a day a week, this is the case with some of our families, they miss 40 days learning, that is 8 weeks of missed learning.** I am being given no choice but to issue penalty notices- please work with us.

Please put **child absence** in the email heading. If you do not do this then it means we need to call you to ascertain why your child is absent.
