Attendance and punctuality:

Well Done Year 5 Aspen, who had best attendance this week at 96.9%. Our overall attendance this week was 91.8%. Let's all aim to get to school next week and improve that percentage! Please ensure your child/ren are in school every day unless they really are unwell or have a temperature or sickness. The attendance officer will issue fines to families if children are persistently absent.

Punctuality. This has improved again this week - please keep this up! Some families who are always late have changed habits and this has made such a huge difference.

Below I have provided information about the department of educations new initiative for all schools.

Your indicative ABIE

Your school's indicative ABIE means your attendance needs to be **0.7 percentage points** higher for the 2025 to 2026 academic year than for the 2024 to 2025 academic year. Your overall attendance for the 2025 to 2026 academic year needs to be at least **91.7%** to achieve this.

This is **the minimum improvement** you should expect to make this academic year.

If your school meets or exceeds this ABIE, your pupils will gain at least **244 extra school days**, compared to last year.

Your ABIE is a starting point, not a limit. We know many schools will target and achieve gains well beyond their ABIE. We encourage you to aim high.

<u>Illness:</u> If your child is unwell, you MUST call the school office by 9am and speak to someone or leave a voice message. You can also email, <u>admin@oldoak.lbhf.sch.uk</u>. Please put **child absence** in the email heading. If you do not do this then it means we need to call you to ascertain why your child is unwell.

Christmas cards

Please ensure you have ordered your child/ren's card design by midnight on Tuesday 2nd December – this is the deadline to ensure orders are here before we finish on the last day of term. The school do receive a small amount of commission so this is fantastic for us.

Your Say: child's survey

All children in year 1-6 will complete an online survey about their school experience, similar to the survey that we asked you to complete so we can see what we are doing well and what the children consider we need to do better. I will share the outcomes after the holidays with you.
