SAFETY AT THE SCHOOL GATE - COMING INTO SCHOOL

An important reminder that to keep children safe we have to monitor very closely everybody who comes onto the school premises. This means that if you do come into the school during school hours, you only do so alone. Please do not allow other, unknown adults come in the school behind you.

Staff will approach any adult who is on the school premises who we do not know.

BOOKING PLACES AT PLAYCENTRE - JANUARY 2024

We have now changed the way After School Club (Playcentre) is booked. Places must now be booked and paid for in advance each day to attend that evening. School Money is now set up to allow parents to book until 2pm that day for a place that evening. At 2pm the registers will close and anyone not on the list will not be able to stay that evening. contact Kelly, our School Business Manager, and she will arrange this on School Money so you can do so for an extended period.

SUPPORT FOR FAMILIES: FAMILY HUBS ARE COMING TO H&F THIS YEAR

Our new Family Hubs will offer a range of services to help support local families. All children and young people will be catered for, from prenatal to adulthood, as well as their entire families.

This includes activities for children aged 0 to five, as well as youth clubs. Plus, we can help with drug and alcohol support, mental health, and support with financial stress.

Each Hub will be the place for families to get help from H&F's family support team, who will have access to their case history.

Our first new Family Hub will open at the Stephen Wiltshire Centre in Fulham in February which will be specifically for families with a child that has special educational needs and disabilities (SEND). The other Family Hubs will be located in Old Oak W12 and Fulham Court SW6.
