Dear families,

Many thanks to all the families that attended parent meetings on Tuesday- it was great to see so many of you. Thank you to those who completed a feedback sheet so we can put all of the comments on the website.

BLACK HISTORY PARTY - WEDNESDAY 22nd OCTOBER 3.30-4.40pm:

We will be celebrating Black History with a party, to showcase artwork the children produce, combined with music, dance, traditional dress and food. We would be grateful for any food donations. If you are able to make something to share, please drop this at school on the morning of the 22nd Oct, with ingredients clearly labelled. Please note we can accept no nut dishes due to allergies. It would be fantastic if you could share a little about the traditions of the dish and the country where it originates. Children can come to school on the 22nd dressed in either party clothes or traditional dress.

INJURIES IN SCHOOL – INFORMING YOU USING AN ONLINE SYSTEM

We are now using our information management system to inform families about injuries and accidents at school. From next week, you will receive an electronic text from the school informing you that your child has been involved in an accident at school. This will replace the paper slips we have sent home. We will continue to call home to share serious concerns and head injuries.

ORDERING SCHOOL MEALS- THE PANTRY

Pantry our School Meals provider will be launching their online order system from Monday the 4th November 2024. This will mean your child school lunch will need to be ordered online in advance. We have included some information with today's newsletter to explain further and to help get things set up. You should have been sent an email from The Pantry today with a sign up link for the online system. If you have already registered please do not worry about doing again. The Pantry will also be holding a workshop on Monday the 21st till 10am in the upstairs hall to help any of you that may need help setting up your online accounts. If you have any problems with the online order systems please call the number provided in the attached information pack as the school will be unable to take the orders for you.

<u>HARVEST COLLECTION</u> - We are getting quite a collection for Harvest- you still have time to contribute. This will close next Thursday and the food will been distributed after the half term.

WICK COURT RESIDENTIAL:

We are looking forward to our upper KS2 residential trip to Wick Court Farm at the beginning of December. There is a meeting for families of those attending on Monday at 2.30pm in the lower hall – this will be a chance to find out more information, fill in consent and medical forms and ask any questions you may have.

PARENTAL VISITS -

Recently we had a visit from a parent who shared his expertise – he works in the medical profession – and he showed the children how they can stay healthy and the importance of washing hands to stop getting ill. SEESAW

We use seesaw as a communication tool for you to keep in contact with your children's class teacher. This is also where the children's home learning is saved and messages are sent that are applicable to your class. Please ensure you regularly check seesaw and engage as much as you can.

Black History Party


You can wear traditional dress or party clothes! Tuesday 22nd October

Flu immunisation for pupils in school years Reception - Year 11

DEAR PARENT/CARER,

The flu vaccine is being offered at your child's school again this autumn/winter.

THE NASAL FLU VACCINE

- Protects your child from the flu
- Protects your family and friends from the flu (especially those who are elderly, young babies, or those who have serious health conditions)
- Is painless, quick and effective
- √ Is free
- √ The nasal flu vaccine is very effective at reducing the spread of flu

THE IM FLU VACCINE



We also offer the flu vaccine as an injection, which is gelatine-free. Please see our Frequently Asked Questions for more information.

You only need to complete one consent form for each child. If you later change your mind, please call your local team. If your child has this immunisation elsewhere after you have submitted the consent form, you MUST inform Vaccination UK rather than the school.

We understand that you may have questions about the vaccine. For more information, please go to our website, where you can find a list of FAQ's, as well as details of our community catch up clinics. We also have some FAQ's enclosed below.

USEFUL INFO



We try to come to your child's school twice. If they are absent or unable to be vaccinated at school, you will need to attend one of our community clinics for the vaccine. Details of these can be found on our website or you can contact the team above.



PLEASE NOTE the flu vaccine will NOT be available to otherwise healthy children after December 13th at all, and so we urge you to return the consent form as soon as possible in case we are not able to visit your child's schools for a second visit this year.



Your consent will remain in place for the entire flu season. If your child misses a first visit, you do not need to complete a second form.


