Dear Parents/Carers,

PE: The children will have 2 PE sessions a week: swimming on Monday and a session with Mike from QPR on Thursday. It is essential that your child has a one-piece, tight, swimming costume, made of the correct material for swimming. Baggy costumes weigh the children down, make it harder to swim and may be dangerous for them and others if they get caught on something or someone. All jewellery must be removed.

Please ensure your child comes to school in the correct PE Kit on Thursday – Trainers, dark shorts/ leggings, plain white/navy T-shirt. This term's PE will be outside as much as possible. Please ensure that your child brings warm, suitable clothing.

Water bottles: It is vital that each child brings a water bottle to school each day, to ensure they stay hydrated. Please ensure your child has a water bottle with their name on it.

Homework: Homework will start on Seesaw nest week – there will be weekly spellings plus an English and Maths task.







Reading: It is so important to read as much as possible at home. Reading books will be sent home to be read for at least 15 mins a day. Please encourage your child to read to you and discuss the book together, please leave a comment in their reading record as a way of communicating this.

Music: The children will have a weekly singing assembly and a weekly music session. They will be learning to play the Ukulele on a Tuesday with Mikey.
