PE: The children will have 2 PE sessions a week. Please ensure your child comes to school in the correct PE Kit — Trainers, dark shorts/ leggings/tracksuit bottoms, plain white/navy T-shirt. The children may be required to take their shoes off. Please ensure the children are wearing footwear they can remove and put back on, easily.

Water bottles: It is vital that each child brings a water bottle to school each day, to ensure they stay hydrated. Please ensure your child has a water bottle with their name on it.

Homework: Homework will continue to be set on Seesaw on <u>Fridays</u> with the aim of completing the tasks by the following <u>Wednesday</u>.

Reading: It is so important to read as much as possible at home – thank you for continuing to support your child's reading. Your child will have a specific day when their reading books will be sent home. You will be notified about your child's day on their new Monkey Reading Records. Please encourage your child to read to you and discuss the book together.

Phonics books: We are making changes to how we distribute Rhino Reader's phonics books. More info to follow on this in the very near future.

Music: The children will have a weekly singing assembly with Ms Beardsworth and an in-class weekly music and instruments session with Miss McCartney.
