Water bottles: It is vital that each child brings a water bottle to school each day, to ensure they stay hydrated. Please ensure your child has a water bottle with their name on it.

Homework: Homework will continue to be set on Seesaw on <u>Fridays</u> with the aim of completing the tasks by the following <u>Wednesday</u>.

Reading: It is so important to read as much as possible at home – thank you for continuing to support your child's reading. Reading books (hard copy and E books) and library books will be sent home on a **Friday**. Please encourage your child to read to you and discuss the book together.

E- books: Please remember to use the home e-code (found in the reading record books) that will enable you to access a rhino reader e-book on Twinkl. This e-book will be based on the book your child is reading in class. E-book codes will be changed fortnightly, we would also like parents to add a comment next to the codes in your child's reading record book. Please let us know if you are having trouble accessing this.

Music: The children will have a weekly singing assembly and a weekly music session. The children's Music session will continue to take place on a Monday with Emily.

Curriculum Map: The included sheet gives details of what your child will be learning this term. The IPC units we will be covering are 'Treasure Island' and 'Earth Our Home'.
