What we will be learning:

The children have settled quickly into the new term. It has been wonderful to see how much progress they have made since they started in September. Our new topic is 'Houses and homes' and our Power of Reading book is 'Owl Babies'.

Literacy:

We are now onto Level 3 phonics. We are going to be focusing on decoding and reading words accurately, applying sounds to writing/ captions and retelling stories in their own words

Numeracy:

In maths we will be finding 1 more/ fewer to 10. Knowing different number combinations to 5 (then 10) and exploring weight and capacity.

Reading:

Please make sure that you are regularly reading with your child. We recommend reading for 10 minutes every day, little and often. Please sign your child's Reading Record, so that we know that they have read.

Seesaw:

The book that we have read during our phonics session is put on Seesaw. Please can you reply to the activity, so we know that it has been read.

Twinkl Learn:

Most children now have a Twinkl Learn login (which is in their Reading Record). Please speak to a member of the team if you are having difficulty accessing the books.
