What we will be learning:

The children have settled quickly into the new term. This term we will be focusing on getting the children ready for Year 1. Our new topic is 'Growing and changing'. We will be thinking about how living things grow and change and soon we will be watching ducks!

Literacy:

We are nearly finished Level 3 phonics and will soon be moving on to Level 4.

Numeracy:

In maths we will be beginning to think about number bonds to 10, 1 more and less to 20. Doubles, odd and evens. We will also be trying maths problems and encouraging children to record.

Most children now have a Twinkl Learn login (which is in their Reading Record). Please speak to a member of the team if you are having difficulty accessing the books
