PE: The children will have 2 PE sessions a week. Please ensure your child comes to school in the correct PE Kit – Trainers, dark shorts/ leggings/tracksuit bottoms, plain white/navy T-shirt. This term **Thursday** PE will be multi-skills. The children may be required to take their shoes off. Please ensure the children are wearing footwear they can remove and put back on, easily.

Water bottles: It is vital that each child brings a water bottle to school each day, to ensure they stay hydrated. Please ensure your child has a water bottle with their name on it.

Homework: Homework will continue to be set on Seesaw on **Fridays** with the aim of completing the tasks by the following **Thursday**. Additionally, the children will start having spelling tests on **Friday**. The words will be those learnt as part of the children's Phonics lessons.

Reading: It is so important to read as much as possible at home – thank you for continuing to support your child's reading. Reading books (hard copy and E books) and library books will be sent home on a **Friday**. Please encourage your child to read to you and discuss the book together.

E- books: Just a reminder that we send home a code that enables you to access a rhino reader e-book on Twinkl. This e-book is based on the book your child is reading in class. E-book codes are changed fortnightly, please remember to add a comment next to the codes in your child's reading record book.

Music: The children will have a weekly singing assembly and a weekly music session. The children's Music session will continue to take place on a **Monday**.

Curriculum Map: Please refer to the Summer curriculum map in order to see what the children will be learning in school.

Year 1 Phonics: In June, the children will have a Phonics Screening, where they will be expected to read a variety of words based on the phonics sounds they have learnt this year. In the weeks leading up to the Phonics Screening, we will set homework based around reading real and alien words. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact me.
