PE: The children will have 2 PE sessions a week. Please ensure your child comes to school in the correct PE Kit – trainers, dark shorts/leggings, plain white/navy T-shirt. Homework: Homework will continue to be posted on Seesaw every Friday afternoon. The expectation is that all homework is completed/submitted by the following Wednesday morning. On Fridays, the class will be having a weekly spelling test. The spellings will be set as part of the homework on Seesaw, so please support your child in the learning of these

Reading: It is so important to read as much as possible at home – thank you for supporting your child with this. Reading books will continue to be sent home weekly and library books will continue to be issued from the school library. Please encourage your child to read to you and discuss the book together. *Your child has been allocated a day of the week when they must bring in their reading packs.

Music: The children will have a weekly singing assembly and a weekly music session. They will be Continuing to learn to play the recorder, on a Tuesday, with Alex.
